## Mantra for Peace – the Upanishad way!

The Upanishads are part of the Vedas. Each of the four Vedas, i.e., the Rig, the Yajur, the Sama and the Atharva, is organized into four sections – the Samhita, the Brahmana, Aranyaka and the Upanishad. Upanishads are the last, i.e. fourth and newest ‘layer’ of the Vedas (this ‘new’ layer was added about 2,700 years ago); they are not hymns but stories, and / or conversations between teacher (Guru) and student (Shishya).

Each Upanishad is not only associated with a particular Veda, but also with a special invocation or prayer called a Shanti Mantra, which is essentially a prayer for peace. Before you start reading an Upanishad – or, more correctly, ‘listening’ to a teacher explain its essence to you – it is recommended to chant the peace prayer associated with it.

### Shanti Mantras

Why should Shanti mantras be recited before the study of an Upanishad? Simply because the sounds and words of these mantras are believed to create an atmosphere that quietens the mind and facilitates learning. As a collateral benefit, they also help calm the community and the environment around the student. Considering this fact, all of these mantras end with that most calming of calming phrases – ‘Aum Shantih Shantih Shantih’.

The triple Shantih mantra invokes three kinds of peace – peace in the mind, peace in speech (i.e., an absence of extreme emotions like anger, fear, hate, great joy or excitement when one speaks) and peace in the body (a steady pulse, a deep rhythmic breath, a happy gut). Another explanation is that the triple Shantih calls for peace within oneself, peace in the community/environment, and peace in the universe



**SIR 2025**

The Special Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls (SIR) is a privilege for the Election Commission to revise the list of voters in any state. It is a routine activity to revise the roll with the inclusion, deletion and modification of voters and their details. It is a time-consuming, delicate process taken over by the commission to ensure that all eligible voters exercise their franchise promptly.



Ahead of Bihar assembly elections in the later part of this year, a huge controversy has developed in the Indian political scene that the EC has unconstitutionally, unlawfully deleted 65 million voters from the roll to facilitate and favour the ruling BJP's win in the elections.

The massive drive carried out by the EC from 24th June required a door-to-door verification of voters' details and filling of enumeration forms along with voter ids, Aadhar ids etc. to booth level officers. This massive revamping of the entire roll revision process triggered protests from the opposition and a portion of common people as well.

Their key concerns include *Targeted timing of SIR before assembly elections, fears of exclusion who likely to oppose NDA, burdening of producing documents, scrutinizing of youth born after 1987 need to furnish parent's date and place of birth, documents like Aadhaar and MNREGA cards are not accepted as valid ID and exclusion of migrant workers and students.*

*Critics say that the SIR process is not an electoral reform, but a targeted, tedious task ahead of nearing elections.*

*When asked about this, Techno-Gandhian Balamurali Balaji says that voting must be a right for every citizen and the EC must ensure that. It also requires a policy shift in choosing the electorate based on citizenship, ownership to avoid fake votes and forgery, he said.*

Imagine a state that provides voting rights only for house owners, land or property owners, business owners who pay taxes and want their tax money working for them in the constituency.

All other citizens are just visitors, guests, or tenants having no right to take part in decision-making processes taken by the democratic government elected by owners alone. These people live in a place because of survival or livelihood with no permanent status or interest in the community they live. Anyways, in the political process, they do have minimal involvement even now.

Therefore, the demarcation is between the owned and the disowned, as opposed to Karl Marx's theory of 'haves and

expertise. Even though environmental and geo-political conditions of those nations determine the fate of their economy, we still need to look at ways of improving them for the best.

**Achieving equity in the global economy** is a complex challenge—one that involves balancing power, opportunity, and sustainability across nations. Equity is not just about redistribution—it is about co-creation. When nations collaborate to build systems that reflect shared values and mutual benefit, equity becomes not just possible, but inevitable.

#### Conceptual Equation for Global Economic Equity

$$\text{Equity Index} = \frac{(A + T + I + S)}{P}$$

Where:

- A = Access to Resources** Includes food, water, energy, education, healthcare, and digital infrastructure.
- T = Trade Fairness** Reflects balanced trade agreements, reduced tariffs for developing nations, and ethical sourcing.
- I = Inclusive Innovation** Measures how technology and innovation are shared globally, not hoarded by a few.
- S = Sustainable Development** Captures environmental stewardship, climate resilience, and long-term planning.
- P = Power Concentration** Represents the degree to which economic and political power is concentrated in a few countries or corporations. Lower values of P improve equity.

Equity increases when there is an rise in access, fairness, innovation, and sustainability. Equity decreases when power is overly concentrated, whether in wealth, decision-making, or technology. Nations longing for such amicable equity

have not's has a greater advantage over the electorate if voter list is shrunk and curtailed based on that. It is also not wrong to follow this pattern of 'creating a voter list' for the privileged. Here, the deprived is not actually poor; they just did not own a one in that place. They might have owned house or property in another town or constituency where they would get voting rights.

The current turbulence over 6.5 million voters, outsiders not enlisted in the voter list in Bihar, for the upcoming Assembly Elections, may find their names in the voter list in other states!

The Election Commission does have no clear ways, on its own, to decide who has the voting right or not. It requires cross checking of Identity, citizenship, age and residential status of the electorate.

Even though the theory of 'haves and have-nots' is associated with economic sufficiency, the idea of possession and dispossession seems to be a deciding factor for fixing the rights of a citizen in a particular place, village, town or city. This might also shift the perspective of looking at people's development from a rich-poor enigma to one's status of ownership/proprietary reducing the gap between the rich and the poor. ●

#### Weird use of technology in TN ration shops

Ration shops in TamilNadu has implemented a new technological way to check the weights of commodities. From August 2025, weighing machine in ration shops became Bluetooth-enabled, which crosscheck the weights of items at the time of billing itself. The billing machine and electronic weighing machine are connected via Bluetooth. When an entry is made in the billing machine for a specified quantity during purchase, the weighing machine weighs the item and matches it with the quantity specified in the billing machine. This new system is launched to ensure the ration shops supply the correct quantity of items to its customers.

The state's Public Distribution System (PDS) shops are always under criticism as people complain more often about less quantity of items they buy. To address the issue, the PDS department has introduced this Bluetooth-enabled cross verification of quantity. Accordingly, billing and measuring the quantity of item happen simultaneously..



However, the implementation has raised objections and frustration from both the customers and the working personnel. It is reported that it is impractical and time-consuming effort to crosscheck each item, and both billing and weighing at the same time. The system requires the weighing machine to receive the signal from the billing machine when an item is billed, then weighs the item is matched and then sends the signal to the billing desk. Only after much time, a single item purchase is completed.

In practical terms, it is not possible to weigh and distribute the item at the time of billing itself as the ration shops have different counters for billing and issuing. Customers get the bill first and produce it at the issuing counter to receive the items. The introduction of new system delays every

in trade and commerce need to work hard to meet the above factors on its own first, and then look for cooperation from countries of similar interest. ●

transaction and the staff are frustrated to cope up with the change.

Many shops surpass this new procedure. Alternatively, some shops make use of dummy weights of various measures, 500gms, 1 kg, 2kg and 5 kg for crosschecking while billing. Once the bill is ready, the actual weighing of items for issuance follow.

Instead of messing up like this, a weighing machine could be placed outside the shop and let the people to check the quantities of items on their own.

Thus, thinking of implementing an innovative use of technology to weigh the correct measures, the PDS has paved a way for inefficiency and for another malpractice. ●
